RISK POLICY

AMA is committed to providing a sporting environment which is safe, stable, and free of discrimination or harassment, and in which risks are minimised through proactive management.

AMA accepts risk management as one of its prime responsibilities and will ensure it is an integral part of any decision-making process. Risk occurs not only within athletics, but also within the more general environment in which AMA operates.

In formulating this policy, AMA is mindful of the full range of risks which may impact on the viability of the organisation, and in turn on the current and future operation of the member clubs themselves.

To protect the organization, its members and the wider community, AMA will incorporate in its governance documents a risk management plan aimed at reducing the likelihood of risk arising. Where risk cannot be eliminated or minimised then AMA will ensure its operations and those of its member clubs are covered by adequate guidelines and appropriate insurance.
