



## Steve McGugan – AMA Vice President

Steve is a member of the Northern Territory Masters Athletics Committee, was 2017 Chair of the LOC for Darwin's first Australian Masters Athletics Championships and while currently the AMA Vice President, he has been on the AMA Board since 2013.

With a master's degree in Education, Steve has worked nationally and internationally in the sports industry and is currently teaching maths at Darwin High School.

Steve has been a member of six Australian Masters Indoor teams and has been on management for AMA sides at four WMA Championships. He was senior manager at Perth in 2016 where the AMA team had 1600 members. He started masters athletics as a 50 year old in 2002 and initially trained with Peter Crombie on Sydney's Northern Beaches. As a junior he won a number of NSW CHS High Jump Championships, annually placed in top 3 of hurdles and represented NSW CHS alongside Clay Tompkins and Mike Hurst.

Steve has won AMA championships for hurdles, medalled in jumps and been a finalist in four WMA Indoor meets. His best placings at WMA meets are 4th in M60 hurdles and the indoor pentathlon. Steve is an accredited AA official, coach and an Australian Sports Achievement Award recipient.

Originally from Sydney, Steve was an assistant coach with Sydney Kings in the halcyon days of basketball, played first grade cricket alongside Allan Border at the Mosman Club after going through the grades with Allan as a junior, was selected in an Australian Schools cricket team and played rugby with the Forest Club from where he also represented Gordon.
