25th AMA Winter Throws Championships Report, Results and Records

The 25th running of the AMA Winter Throws Championships was conducted at the Kerryn McCann Athletics Centre, Wollongong, over the traditional Labour Day long weekend of Saturday October 3rd to Monday October 5th. The meet was conducted by NSW Masters Athletics, in conjunction with the home club Athletics Wollongong, and the staff of the Beaton Park Leisure Centre venue.

The weather was favourable, with daily maximum temperatures in the mid-twenties on Saturday and Sunday, and breaking thirty on Monday, and we enjoyed pleasant, rain-free conditions with moderate winds over the entire event.

Attendance numbers at the Wollongong event were significantly down this year, due to the COVID-19 interstate lockdowns and travel restrictions, unfortunately decimating the non-NSW entries. Only 31 throwers could travel to compete in person, comprising of 28 NSW, 2 ACT and 1 WA athlete. Those entered were 17 male athletes ranging in age groups from M40 – M80, whilst the 14 female athletes were in the age groups W35 - W65.

So, thinking fast in the pivot spirit of 2020, we quickly decided to add in a Virtual Competition, to run in tandem with the Championships, for those unable to travel out of their states. This action proved to be very successful, with 62 entries from both regular Winter Throwers and also from a substantial number of first-time participants (*review of the Virtual event on pages 7-9*).

The Main Event

The first time running a COVID safe competition certainly had its challenges this year, but armed with social distancing instructions, industrial sized bottles of sanitizer and copious printed check in lists, we were determined to deliver our usual high standard competition event, in a safe and socially distanced format.

My committee of Adriana van Bockel, Gabi Watts and Robert Clark all worked hard in preparation for the event, with a hand from Stuart Gyngell with the event program. Nurse Mary Thomas was on hand also, armed with our new thermal thermometer - unable to compete due to injury, she manned the COVID check in desk and recorded like the champion she is. An extra big shout out to Gabi and husband Dave over the whole event with their outstanding equipment and results management.

Day 1 - The Throws Pentathlon

The first day comprised the Throws Pentathlon, plus the 56lb and 100lb Weights, as the Championship followed the amended program format which was introduced in 2018.

Amongst the ladies, strong results came in all age groups. **Jill Taylor W65** recorded the highest score with an impressive 3770 points. Her pentathlon also included NSW State & Meet Records in

the Weight Throw (13.74m). **Odette Palma W35** amassed 3461 points to break the NSW State Record for her age group. **Gabi Watts W50** (3509 points), **Vicki Townsend W55** (3487 points) and **Christine Shaw W60** (3345 points) all produced substantial scores.

The W40 age group provided the closest competition in the ladies Throws Pentathlon, as **Kelly Hunter W40** struck an early lead in the Hammer (27.45m), with **Kate Adams W40** closing the gap with a fine Shot (10.09m). Kelly launched a big Discus (34.13m) but Kate was still there to snatch a 25 point lead, after propelling her Javelin (31.75m) into the heavens. So it all came down to the Weight Throw, where Kelly's 10.98m proved just too strong.

An epic contest occurred in the W60s, which saw **Sharon Gibbins W60** put **Christine Shaw W60** under huge pressure through an impressive Hammer (31.52m) and strong performances in the Shot (7.27m) and Discus (21.94m). However, the competition was determined by Christine's stellar Javelin (25.10m), which left Sharon with too much work to do in the Weight to gain back the lead.

Whilst the men's scores were lower than the ladies, strong results were recorded by competitors in a number of age groups during the day. **Ray Green M75** recorded the highest score with an impressive 3284 points with **Arnie Delaite M75** (3185 points) close behind. **Robert Hanbury Brown M60** matched Arnie's point score (3185 points), and **Jamie Muscat M40** produced a commendable total of 3071 points in his age group.

The Men's events produced some of the closest throws pentathlon finishes we have seen in Winter Throws history - **Ian Guthrie M65** took an early advantage with his Hammer (29.15m) and consolidated his position with the Shot (8.50m) to lead by 107 points. **David Ross M65** then halved this advantage with his Discus (25.08m), then his fabulous Javelin (25.08m) propelled him in to a 50 point lead. Ian's Weight Throw (11.78m) looked like it could be enough to take the win, but when the final points were tallied, David had hung on to win by a single point (2379 points to 2378 points).

Then in the M55, **Robert Clark M55** took a big early lead with the Hammer (36.26m), **Stephen Liggins M55** produced a magnificent Shot (10.88m) to move within 9 points, with **Peter Murray M55** Shot (9.81m) put him just 35 points further behind. Stephen's huge throws in the Discus (35.13m) and Javelin (37.11m) looked decisive, as he extended his lead to 135 points over Peter and 249 points over Robert. But Robert's Weight Throw (14.59m) had everyone calculating and checking the final point totals, as Stephen held on to win by a point from Robert (2994 points to 2993 points) with Peter finishing a close third (2848 points).

Finally, **Ray Green M75** took an early lead in his group with his Hammer (29.12m), then consolidated this with his Shot (9.82m) and Discus (31.46m), to lead **Arnie Delaite M75** by 195 points. However, Arnie then produced a huge Javelin (27.51m) to close the gap to just 5 points with the Weight Throw to come. Ray's Weight Throw (12.13m) was good enough to close out the competition, however Arnie could console himself with the second best points total across all the male age groups on the day.

The 56lb and 100lb events

After the drama of the Throws Pentathlons, it was time for the strong men and women to show off their prowess with the 56 and 100lbs, and how they demonstrated it!

Vicki Townsend W35 (1.89m) and Jill Taylor W65 (1.63m) set new Australian, NSW and Meet Records in the 100lb. Vicki (3.46m) and Jill (2.86m) also set new NSW State Records in the 56lb. Ray Green M75 (4.60m) also set a new Meet Record in the 56lb, while Noel Donohoe M80 (6.40m) set NSW State and Meet Records in his Super Weight (20lb).

Other strong performances were achieved by **Jamie Muscat M40** in the 56lb (8.51m) and in the 100lb (4.68m), **Morgan Clifford M40** (3.54m) in the 100lb, and **Anatoly Kirievsky M40** in the 56lb (6.36m) and 100lb (3.40m).

Unfortunately, the Championship Dinner was unable to be held this year due to the COVID-19 restrictions, but we hope to be able to bring it back for the 2021 event.



Day 2 – The Individual Events

Day 2 brought forth the Individual Events of Hammer, Shot Put, Discus, Javelin and Weight Throw. Athletes today were sorted into three separate groups to keep them small, to help with both social distancing and the speed with which each event could be completed. With three separate EDMs in operation to measure distances, each event ran quickly and smoothly.

The Hammer saw **Odette Palma W35** (53.75m) throw a NSW State and Meet Record. **Maria Cimino W45** (40.99m), **Jamie Muscat M40** (39.73m) and **Gabi Watts W50** (38.75m) all threw impressive distances.

In the Shot **Kate Adams W40** (10.52m) and **Kelly Hunter W40** (10.40m) produced another titanic, quality battle. **Jamie Muscat M40** (12.42m) and **Gabi Watts W50** (10.99m) threw well, whilst **Ray Green M75** showed his younger competitors how to do it with an awesome distance of 9.85m.

The Discus saw Kelly Hunter W40 (41.36m) break the current Meet Record, and Ray Green M75 (31.50m), Jamie Muscat M40 (40.20m), Robert Hanbury Brown M60 (36.50m) and Gabi Watts

W50 (32.19m) also notched good marks. In one of the closest Javelin battles of the day, **Sharon Gibbons W60** (23.01m) proved just that bit too strong for **Christine Shaw W60** (22.29m).

The Javelin saw another Meet Record fall, this time to **Nick Batty M50** (56.03m), a distance that many of us couldn't match from all our throws combined! **Morgan Clifford M40** (32.66m), **Jamie Muscat M40** (32.26m) and **Anatoly Kirievsky** (30.07m) produced the closest competition of the day, whilst **Kate Adams W40** (30.99m), **John Appleton M75** (26.46m) and **Christine Shaw W60** (25.08m) all produced great throws.

The Weight Throw saw great throws from **Ray Green M75** (13.06m), **Robert Hanbury Brown M60** (14.61m), **Robert Clark M55** (14.32m) and **Jill Taylor W65** (13.34m), and **Christine Shaw W60** (12.03m) and **Sharon Gibbons W60** (11.51m) had yet another of their great tussles, with Christine just prevailing.

Not surprisingly, the unique Weight for Distance event also saw many new Meet Records set. 2 women set new marks – **Kelly Hunter W40** (13.35m) and **Jill Taylor W65** (18.49m) – and 2 men – **Ray Green M75** (16.99m) and **Noel Donohoe M80** (13.55m). **David Ross M65** (15.06m) **Jamie Muscat M40** (15.96m) and **Robert Hanbury Brown M60** (15.75m) all threw over 15 metres each.

Day 3 – Heavy Weight Pentathlon

Our final competition day, Monday was certainly the pick of the days weatherwise, and a chance for the remaining group of hardcore throwers to produce one final day of quality throwing.

The ladies again provided some outstanding performances. **Jill Taylor W65** (4640 points) amassed the highest point score, setting new NSW State Records in the HWP and the Super Weight (20lb), with the Super Weight also being a Meet Record. **Odette Palma W35** (4067 points) threw an

Australian Record in the Super Weight (8.87m), and **Maria Cimino W45** (3701 points) threw consistently well across all the weights to amass a high score. Both Maria (6.57m) and Odette (8.87m) also set Super Weight NSW State and Meet Records.

Amongst the men, **Ray Green M75** (3717 points), **Robert Clark M55** (3714 points) and **Jamie Muscat M40** (3409 points) recorded substantial points total reflecting consistent throwing with all weights.

Female Athlete: Jill Taylor W65 (NSW)

Over three days of stunning competition there were three women whose performances shone the brightest: **Odette Palma W35** (NSW), **Vicki Townsend W55** (NSW) and **Jill Taylor W65** (NSW). Each achieved quality results, as demonstrated by the Australian, State and Meet Records they set. Each performed brilliantly across a number of events, and it was difficult to split them. Given the sheer breadth and quality of performances over the event, the decision ultimately went to **Jill Taylor W65**, for the consistency of her performances in both

pentathlons, and across the individual events.

Although there were a number of very strong male performances across the weekend, there was only really one male athlete whose performances were consistently at the highest level. He achieved the highest Male Throws Pentathlon Score, the highest Male Heavy Weight Pentathlon, and a number of strong individual performances, which included Meet records in the Javelin, Weight for Distance and the 56lb, making **Ray Green M75** a very worthy winner of the 2020 Male Athlete of the Meet.

Our Virtual Competition rundown

The virtual competition attracted the awesome number of 62 throwers, with representation from every State and territory in Australia.

The breakdown was: 16 ACT, 12 NT, 11 VIC, 10 QLD, 5 WA, 5 NSW, 2 SA, and 1 TAS. The 29 male and 33 female athletes entered ranged in the age groups from MW35 to MW80. **Locations included:**

Bunbury, Adelaide, Darwin, Hobart, Bendigo, Melbourne, Canberra, Sydney, Mackay, Bundaberg, Brisbane.



Throws Pentathlon

Amongst the ladies, **Jeanette Williamson W75** (3902 points) recorded the highest TP score, with **Jayne Hardy W55** (3773 points) second. Other scores over 3000 points were **Nicole Johansen W45** (3441 points), **Alex Lloyd W60** (3324 points), **Narelle Messerle W60** (3062 points) and **Jennifer Parker W50** (3050 points). There was also a fabulous contest in our W80 age group between **Maggie Roberts W80** (2133 points), **Nola Brockie W80** (2061 points) and **Nola de Chazal W80** (1404 points).

In the men's competition, **Chris White M50** (3604 points) recorded the highest, an impressive score which was over 300 points more than any male who had competed at the main event in Wollongong. Other scores over 3000 points were **Kevin Blewitt M80** (3329 points), **John Fettus M45** (3240 points) and **Simon Van Baalen M45** (3083 points).

Heavy Weight Pentathlon

Amongst the ladies **Jeanette Williamson W75** (3983 points) recorded the highest score just pipping **Jayne Hardy W55** (3974 points). **Nicole Johansen W50** (3733 points) scored heavily and **Jennifer Parker W50** (3102 points) was also over 3000 points. **Luella Jones W70** (2046 points) from three weights would surely have joined them, had she been able to throw/score points with all five weights.

In the men, **John Fettus M45** (3886 points) recorded the highest score finishing a long way clear of **Brian Davies M70** (3306 points). Other scores over 3000 points were **Don Quinn M75** (3226 points), **Todd Davey M50** (3211 points), **John Reynolds M75** (3153 points) **Lajos Joni M65** (3101 points), **Richard Harris M45** (3097 points) and **Ian Grazioli M60** (3023 points). It is worth noting that Lajos and Todd's scores were amassed from four weights only Oh, what might have been!

We hope that all border lockdowns and COVID 19 restrictions will be gone by next year's event and that many of these first timers might be able to make it in person to the 26th AMA Winter Throws Championships. Failing that, we have already undertaken to run the virtual competition again in 2021. The opportunity to connect with so many of our athletes around Australia, many who have never competed in some of the events that the Winter Throws Championships offer, is too good not to repeat in the future.
