



CONDITIONS FOR THE 2021 VIRTUAL MULTI-EVENT COMPETITION ARE:

- Athletes wishing to compete virtually must enter the 2021 Australian Masters Multi-Event Championships via the link below:

- Cost is \$30.00
- Victorian athletes must compete in Bendigo;
- Interstate athletes can choose to compete in Bendigo or virtually;
- State Associations are eligible to participate if their Multi's are scheduled from this weekend (16/17 January 2021) until the end of March 2021;
- For a State event to be considered outside of this time period approval from the AMA President is required;
- Membership of a State/Territory Masters Association is mandatory;
- The multi-event must be accredited by the athletes State Association;
- Results are to be submitted by the athlete's Association;
- Results should include:
 - i. Event
 - ii. Venue and date
 - iii. Athletes name and Date of Birth
 - iv. Score
 - v. Copy of Official Results
- Performances must be completed under WA/WMA rules and guidelines;
